THE ADMISSIONS PROCESS

How Parents Apply For A Year 7 Place For September 2020

If a child is due to move on to secondary school in September 2020 having completed the primary phase of their education, parents **must** apply for a place at secondary school for their child.

Parents of students in Year 6 at KBA ***only have to apply*** for a secondary school place ***if*** they are looking for a Year 7 place at another school.



THE ADMISSIONS PROCESS

How to apply

- Applications opened on 10th September 2019.
- When you make an application for your child's school place, you will be asked to state up to 3 schools you would like your child to attend (known as your preferences). **You should state these in the order you prefer them.**
- It is very important that parents read our **Admissions Policy** before applying for a place. This gives full details of key information such as our **Admissions Test** (scheduled for Saturday 7th December) and our **over-subscription criteria**.
- We will write to parents who place us as a preference and allocate 1 of 3 times. This will happen once we receive this information from NCC.
- Please be aware that, as per our Admissions Policy, **preference is given to test takers over those who do not take the test.**
