### Frequently Asked Questions:

**Q Which sessions has my child been invited to?**

A Students will be informed in their subject lessons. If they have been invited to any sessions, form tutors will also have a list of the sessions that each student has been invited to.

**Q Will food be available for free or to purchase?**

A There will be no food/drink available, therefore students will need to bring food and water bottles. Year 13 students will be able to leave site to purchase food at set times allocated by staff. If we don't hear from you, we will presume that you are happy for your child to leave the school site.

**Q If a session is stated as being 9am – 3pm do students have to stay the whole day?**

A We would like all students to take full advantage of the staff being in school, however, they are free to leave at an appropriate time by signing out.

**Q Is the school open for students to come in during the day and revise for a subject NOT on this list?**

A YES...the school is OPEN 9am – 3pm on each of the days included in the grid. We will open the library and make computers available for students to work.

**Q If a subject is 9am – 3pm and a student finishes early, can they go to another subject area?**

A Yes, on completion of their work and if the teacher is happy for them to leave, students are more than welcome to continue to study in the academy or swap to another subject.
