

Curriculum

In Year 7 students will have 30 lessons per week. They will study:

- English and Maths 5 lessons
- Science 4 lessons
- History and Geography 3 lessons
- Spanish, French or German and PE 2 lessons
- Music, Art and Design, Drama, RE 1 lesson

Some students may do literacy, numeracy or reading intervention instead of modern foreign languages.

In Year 8 students will select one modern foreign language and pick up ICT.





I will show **determination** by learning from mistakes and not giving up



Uniform

We expect our students to show pride in their uniform.

Where a student does not have a particular item of uniform, parents are expected to provide a written explanation regarding this which should be shown to the form tutor at the start of the day.

If a student arrives at school without appropriate school shoes they will be asked to hand over their footwear and mobile phone, or other item should they not have a mobile phone, before being provided with a pair of black pumps. Once appropriate school shoes are worn these items will be returned.

If there is a medical reason which means that a student cannot wear an item of uniform this must be evidenced with an appropriate medical note.

Homework is expected to be completed whenever set.

Please take an active interest in your child's homework. As a parent you have a role to play in ensuring that students recognize the value in working independently at home – this will help to unlock their true potential.

Failure to complete homework will result in a 60 minute same day detention.


Internal Exclusion

Consequences

The academy makes provision which allows students who are not meeting the requirements of Disruption Free Learning to work outside mainstream lessons for a limited period. This facility is known as the Internal Exclusion Room and is supervised by a member of staff between the hours of 08:00 and 17:00.

Students may also be placed in internal exclusion as a consequence for poor behaviour during breaktime, lunchtime or after school. All students placed in internal exclusion must hand their mobile phone in at the time they enter the internal exclusion room. This device is returned to the student at the time that the period of internal exclusion finishes.

By law schools are able to place pupils under the age of 18 in detention without parental consent outside of normal school hours. There is no legal obligation to give parents notice of the detention. However, in all instances where a student is placed in internal exclusion or detention at Kettering Buccleuch Academy we will attempt to inform parents of this by telephone call, text message or email.

HOW PARENTS CAN HELP

- Establish a good routine in the mornings and evenings so your child is prepared for the school day ahead.




Knowledge Organisers

Accelerated Reader

The *Accelerated Reader* programme is designed to encourage students to raise their reading age but also to understand what they are reading.

All students will read books appropriate to their current reading age.

They will have 20 minutes during the school day to read and are expected to do at least 20 minutes independently.

They then sit a comprehension quiz on the book they have read which gives them a score towards their reading target.

Students are assessed three times a year to monitor their reading progress.



- The academy day will end at 3:00pm




